## **Botani (Sierras de Malaga) Dry**

### The Producer

The facilities are located in the village of Almáchar, which lies nestled in the heart of the Axarquía region of Málaga. This mountainous region of steep slopes and slate soil near the Mediterranean is considered one of the oldest viticultural areas in Europe. The most innovative aspect of our winemaking proposal was to entrust the elaboration of our wines to world-renowned Austrian winemaker, Gerard Kracher, who was undoubtedly the number one in Austrian sweet wines.

Botani comes from vineyards of muscat Alexandria that are between 30 and 80 years old, situated at an altitude of approximately 600 m and in north facing slopes of the mountains of Axarquía. Pruning of the vines follows the vaso system and vine cultivation is through dry farming, following the age-old practices still in use in this region of Málaga.

### General Information

Type of wine: still, white

Alcohol Content: 13.2 %

Grape Variety: Muscat Alexandria

Vinification: Manual harvest at the beginning of August, selected grapes undergo cold maceration. Fermentation is carried out 70% in stainless steel tanks and 30% in french oak.

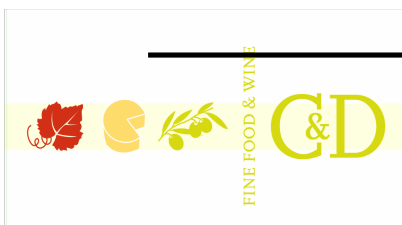
