Cepa 21 Vintage (Ribera del Duero)

The Producer

Bodegas Cepa 21 is an ambitious new project from the Moro family. The grapes from 50 ha of tinto fino vines (the most pure clone of the tempranillo grape) are used in one of the most technologically advanced facilities in the world. Ultra fine control over the fermenting environment has produced wine of an excellent standard.

The winery is located in Ribera del Duero, a land of dry summers and long, hard winters. The soils of the Ribera del Duero imbue the wine with deep colour, good back bone as well as great aromatic potential.

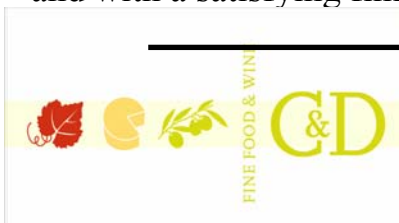

Tasting Notes

This wine displays an intense, ripe black cherry colour. On the nose, it develops well with ripe red berry hints (mulberry and blackcurrant) intermingled with elegant, balsamic, oaky aromas. On the palate it is powerful with nuances of incense, spice and sweet-tasting cinnamon. The sweetness of the ripe tannins combines perfectly with the polyphenolic structure of the Tinto Fino variety. Well balanced, lingering, harmonious and with a satisfying finish.
