Mas d'en Gil is one of the most prestigious wineries in Priorat (one of the most exiting Spanish DOs of the moment). They own a 125 hectare estate in the municipal district of Bellmunt del Priorat. They benefit from a slate soil, a micro-climate of broad temperature ranges and warm, humid air from south easterly breezes. The Rovira family bought the estate in 1981. Taking advantage of the unrivalled natural conditions of the land and combining tradition and technology, they now produce unique and complex wines. One of their wines, Coma Vella 2000, got them the Spanish Red Wine Trophy at the International Wine Challenge 2003.

Tasting Note

On the nose, the intensity is pronounced and shows complex aromas of ripe fruits and spices, with balsamic and mineral notes in the background.

On the palate, this is a powerful, complex and meaty wine with rich flavours, good acidity and a persistent finish.
