The Producer

Mas d'en Gil is one of the most prestigious wineries in Priorat (one of the most exciting Spanish DOs of the moment). They own a 125 hectare estate in the municipal district of Bellmunt del Priorat. They benefit from a slate soil, a micro-climate of broad temperature ranges and warm, humid air from south easterly breezes. The Rovira family bought the estate in 1981. Taking advantage of the unrivalled natural conditions of the land and combining tradition and technology, they now produce unique and complex wines. One of their wines, Coma Vella 2000, won them the Spanish Red Wine Trophy at the International Wine Challenge 2003.

Tasting Notes

Pale straw in colour. Aromas of ripe fruit, some citrus and aromatic forest herbs that are transformed into balsamic and mineral notes as the wine opens up. Powerful and lively entry with the acidity and unctuousness prevailing. Complex structure with a long and persistent finish.



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
