The Producer

The winery is family run and has links with the wine world going back three generations. It is located in Pesquera, Ribera del Duero, a land of dry summers and long, hard winters. The vines used are the purest of the indigenous Tempranillo grape varieties known as Tinto Fino. The soils of the Ribera del Duero provide imbue the wine with deep colour, good back bone as well as great aromatic potential.

Type of wine: still, red

Alcohol Content: 14 %

Grape Variety: 100% Tinto Fino

Vinification: 20 days maceration in stainless steel vats. It was matured in French oak casks for 4 months before bottling

Origin: Spain— DO Ribera del Duero

Vine age: 5-15 yrs



Tasting Notes

A superb example of the subtleties and appeal of a young wine. To the eye, deep cherry colour, clean and glossy showing the powerful of the 2007 vintage. On the nose, there are beautiful over-mature fruit aromas – chiefly blackberry and raspberry – harmoniously combining gentle spice from French oak. On the palate it is warm and welcoming, beautifully structured with lingering finish and very smooth ripe tannins.
