

Bodegas Castillo de Maetierra

Guerrilla Moscatel (Valle de Sadacia, Rioja)

The Producer

The castle stands on the Rioja side of the banks of the river Ebro, only a short distance away from the two thousand year old town of Calahorra and on the Camino de Santiago in Aragon. Under its watchful eye, in lands whose viticultural history stretches back in time, we find its vineyards, burnished by the golden sun of the Valles de Sadacia. The Maetierra estate has more than 350 hectares and it is a market garden undertaking, whose epicentre is organised around the castle and the winery and in which all types of farming produce is painstakingly cultivated, much of it organic. A great spectacle of natural life that can be enjoyed all the year round, following the vegetative cycle of each of the crops, a concept of the earth (tierra) as a generator of life (mother earth), from which, together with the word of Portuguese origin "mae" (mother), Maetierra takes its name

Type of wine: still, white, dry
Alcohol Content: 12.5 %
Grape Variety: Moscatel, Viura and Chardonnay
Vinification: The grapes are put into maceration vats where **cryo-maceration** takes place, thereby extracting all the potential aromas and taste from the Muscat blanc à petits grains, the most aromatic variety in the world
Origin: Spain— VdT Valle de Sadacia



Tasting Notes

Pale straw colour with green hues, making it attractive to the eye, bright and clear. On the nose the wine amazes with its intensity and complexity. It has a deep aroma which combines tropical fruit, white flowers and pâtisserie. In the mouth it is a full wine, surprising you with its high glyceric level, smoothness and roundness. It has a long, persistent finish and in the aftertaste the fruit, flowers and pâtisserie return once again



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
