The Producer

Located in the historic village of San Vicente de la Sonsierra, Bodega Classica rises above a sea of vineyards, flanked by the rivers Ebro and Sierra de Toloño. The range of wines called Lopez de Haro are named after the founder of Bilbao.

The winery is excavated into the side of the mountain, providing excellent year-round temperature control. The grapes enter the winery with the aid of gravity, this being the least harsh method of moving the grapes. The soils in this region are mostly calcareous clay delivering great acidity to the wine.

Hacienda López de Haro is a series of wines combining the simplicity and elegance of great classics adapted to current consumer tastes.

Tasting Notes

A tasty wine, rich in red fruit and liquorice flavours with a sweet tannin structure that leaves a long aftertaste. 3-4 months in new barrels gives the wine added complexity



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
