The Producer

In 1889, the Mahou Solana children laid the foundations for the present day Mahou business by setting up the general partnership Hijos de Casimiro Mahou, engaged in beer and ice manufacturing.

The first beer was brewed in 1891 at the brewery in Madrid. Initially, Mahou concentrated its production on a single type of beer, Pilsner. However, it soon introduced a Munich-style dark lager.

In 1957, the business took its current name, Mahou S.A.

In 1969 the company launched its special **Mahou Cinco Estrellas Lager**, a popular top-quality product renowned for its inimitable aroma and character. During the 1990's, Mahou extended its product range again. **Mahou Clásica**, the company's traditional flavour, and Mahou Cinco Estrellas were joined by **Laiker**, an alcohol-free brew offering all the balance, taste and aroma of a Mahou beer, the product of long years of market and technical research.

Today it remains one of the most modern breweries in the world.
