Mediodía Rosado (Navarra)

The Producer

The name Inurrieta refers to the region where ancestors of the Inurrieta family have cultivated vines for a century. The vines currently cover 200 ha.

Situated between the villages of Falces and Miranda in the Ribera de Navarra, the winery is in a micro climate produced by the river Arga. The atlantic and continental climate provides fresh, humid Northerly winds during the summer and autumn which enhance the aroma and colour of the wines. The clay soils bring freshness and power to the wine.

Vinification: Fermentation at low temperature with 4-6 months on lees

Tasting Notes

Attractive, very lively pink with fuchsia hues. Powerful, inexhaustible aromas of rose petals, enhanced by a whole range of red berries, cherries, mazzards and strawberries. Modern, fresh, very clean and persistent in the mouth. Good balance and just the right acidity to underscore flavours. It is very youthful and evinces good potential.
