Bodegas Fontana owns 500 ha of the best vineyards in La Mancha, located between the provinces of Cuenca and Toledo. The fruit is hand picked and grape selection is done in the vineyard. The winery is located between the two provinces and is equipped with the latest technology to produce red wines of quality. The cellars are air conditioned and can hold up to 200,000 bottles. Bodegas Fontana are very proud of their wines and careful work and dedication are put into the production from the vineyard to the cellar. Tempranillo is the base to all their wines - with some of them being 100% Tempranillo and others being blended with other varieties in order to give the wines more complexity. Most wines are then aged in American oak.
