The Producer

The winery is situated in an elevated position where beautiful panoramic views of the estuary of the river Miño are possible before its final descent into the Atlantic.

The structure of the winery is surrounded by vines on pergolas and the lines of vines smoothly roll downhill towards the river.

In this mild climate, the summers are temperate and the autumn brings rain. The best grapes are meticulously selected in a way that ensures the health of the vines and a good yield.

Tasting Notes

The Nora Da Neve 2006 hue is a blossomy goldness. The nose expresses lifted white peaches, the lushness of ripe orchard apricots and notes of fresh jasmine petal. Without losing and of the nuances of its classic varietal expression, this wine improves in the lasting of its aromatic sequence and in its wealth of flavours. The wood scent is an added pleasure when uncorking the wine, and this sensation is sharpened on the palate
