

Bodegas Inurrieta

Norte (Navarra)

The Producer

The name Inurrieta refers to the region where ancestors of the Inurrieta family have cultivated vines for a century. The vines currently cover 200 ha.

Situated between the villages of Falces and Miranda in the Ribera de Navarra, the winery is in a micro climate produced by the river Arga. The atlantic and continental climate provides fresh, humid Northerly winds during the summer and autumn which enhance the aroma and colour of the wines. The clay soils bring freshness and power to the wine.

General Information

Type of wine: still, red
Alcohol Content: 14.5 %
Grape Variety: 50% Merlot, 50% Cab. Sau.
Vinification: Cold maceration is performed at 10°C over 5 days. Fermentation and further maceration at 24°C takes place for 15 days. Then the wine is aged for 6 months in French oak barrels.
Origin: Spain– DO Navarra



Tasting Notes

This intense ruby coloured red brims with subtle, primary flavours of blackcurrant and cranberries set against a spicy, smokey background of irresistible toasty notes. Fine yet firmly flavoured it has appealingly rounded tannins, yet appreciable depth and length.
