Bodegas Malaga Virgen was founded by the two Lopez brothers at the end of the 19th century. The reputation for their wine grew rapidly and they had to install another wine press to keep up with the increasing demand. The business was later handed over to the next generation: the two brothers' sons – Three young boys who took the company to an even higher level using excellent marketing techniques and who were smart enough to adapt their products to the ever changing market.

Today Malaga Virgen work with the latest technology, still producing wines of unrivalled quality and style and still using the old fashion method of sun drying the grapes to concentrate the sugars.
