

Bodegas Real Sitio de Ventosilla PradoRey Verdejo (Rueda)

The Producer

Bodegas Prado Rey, after nearly 30 years making worldwide renowned wines in the Ribera del Duero DO, have acquired a new *terroir* in the tiny village of La Seca, DO Rueda, where Verdejo and Viura grapes grow unperturbed.

From the creators of the Prado Rey range, the Verdejo sweeps in with the same grace as its precursors.

Grape Variety: 100% Verdejo

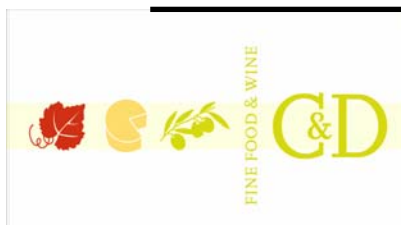
Origin: Spain— Rueda DO

Vinification: The grapes are harvested mechanically at night. The grapes are cooled by the Boreal system in order to obtain the maximum aroma. The grape must is then fermented at 16°C and later aged on the lees with battonage for 4 months in stainless steel deposits.



Tasting Notes

This wine, with appealing greenish tones, features varietal aromas from Verdejo on a complex background and exotic fruit with aniseed hints. It gives an unctuous, fleshy, fat impression in the mouth with an excellent aftertaste. As a good white wine, it is ideal to be enjoyed as an aperitif before meals or to accompany rice-dishes, seafood and obviously fish.



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
