The Producer

The vineyards are located in the Oja and Tirón river valleys of La Rioja Alta, but the winery itself is based on the outskirts of Haro, the historical home of La Rioja's most prestigious bodegas. Bodegas Muga have been a family business ever since its creation in 1932. Over the years, Muga wines have gained international recognition and acclaim. Meticulously faithful to their traditional wine-making methods, Bodegas Muga use French and American oak vats and casks throughout the entire process.

Tasting Note

Deep ruby colour with a garnet rim. The aromas are elegant yet powerful, fruity and mature, with a strong oak influence, which far from being overpowering, respects the wine and gives it elegance and character. On the palate, the wine is lively, meaty, full bodied with perfectly balanced flavours and good structure. The tannins are mature. It also shows hints of vanilla and spices, which leave an unforgettable feeling of quality, elegance and finesse that will improve with the years.
