Victoria (Sierras de Malaga) Sweet

The Producer

The facilities are located in the village of Almáchar, which lies nestled in the heart of the Axarquía region of Málaga. This mountainous region of steep slopes and slate soil near the Mediterranean is considered one of the oldest viticultural areas in Europe. The most innovative aspect of our winemaking proposal was to entrust the elaboration of our wines to world-renowned Austrian winemaker, Gerard Kracher, who was undoubtedly the number one in Austrian sweet wines.

VICTORIA comes from vineyards of muscat alexandria that are between 50 and 70 years old in the mountains of Axarquía, situated at an altitude of approximately 650 m in north facing slopes. Pruning of the vines follows the vaso system and vine cultivation is through dry farming, following the age-old practices still in use in this region of Málaga.

General Information

Type of wine: still, white

Alcohol Content: 13.0 %

Grape Variety: Muscat Alexandria

Vinification: Grapes to make this wine are concentrated by a process of drying in the shade indoors. Manual harvest in mid August. Selected grapes are fermented in stainless steel tanks and, as is characteristic of this type of wine, the alcohol comes exclusively from grape fermentation; this is stopped by cooling down the wine once the desired alcohol content has been reached.

Origin: Spain— DO Sierras de Malaga

Vine age: 50-70 yrs



Tasting Notes

Brilliant yellow hue. Fresh and intense, with a mix of sensations of freshly peeled apple, orange peel, bee pollen and aromatic herbs. Concentrated, fat but refreshing. Long finish.
