The Producer

Bodegas Volver creates wines in other wine-making regions of Spain such as Alicante, La Mancha, Valencia and Almansa.

The soil is sandy with a lot of clay and pieces of chalk beneath and slate on the surface. The altitude of the vineyards is 660m. The vines produce very low yields of 1-2 kg per vine as they are 32 years old.

The terroir has a Mediterranean climate with very warm summers with little or no rainfall and mild, wet winters.

Type of wine: Red wine

Alcohol Content: 15.0%

Grape Variety: Garnacha Tintorera

Origin: Almansa

Vinification: The wine undergoes malolactic fermentation in barrel and it is aged in new French oak barrels for 14 months. Quinta del 67 is unfiltered bottled in the estate.

Tasting Notes

Deep red. Complex in nose with aromas of ripe dark berries, spicy, and some balsamic aromas. On the palate with a lot of structure, silky tannin and again lots of fruit, chocolate, liquorice. Long and persistent finish. Very powerful and with a long life ahead.
