

Olarra Clasico Reserva

The Producer

Bodegas Olarra was created in 1973. It is situated on the outskirts of the city of Logroño in Rioja Alta. The Y shaped building is designed to make optimum use of the space for both production and ageing of the wine. The clay and chalky soil is watered by the rain and the Ebro River. This area also benefits from warm sunshine and the influence of the Mediterranean and Atlantic coasts.

Vinification: It spends 18 months in oak casks.

Tasting Notes

It shows off a beautiful cherry red color with a garnet rim, medium layer, lively and very bright to the eye. The nose shows elegant spicy notes (cinnamon and cloves), to continue with echoes of the fruity series (ripe red fruits, such as cherries and blueberries). The aromatic journey is completed with hints of subtle smokiness and elegant hints of the balsamic series (eucalyptus).
