Chozas Carrascal is a family run winery from Valencia, Eastern Spain. Although the estate dates back to 1870, their project started in 1990 when Julian López rescued old vines of Bobal, planted international varieties and refurbished their National Heritage Winery. Since then, Chozas Carrascal have been extremely focused on producing fine and elegant wines from their unique single estate vineyard, which is classified as VINO DE PAGO, top Spanish designation. The winery is very committed to nature and they contribute to biodiversity, that's why all their wines have EU organic certification.

Type of wine: Red Wine
Alcohol Content: 14.0%
Grape Variety: Bobal, Monastrell, Garnacha Tinta, Tempranillo, Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, Syrah y Merlot.
Origin: Utiel-Requena
Vinification: In barrels for 14 months approximately, depending on the evolution of the wine.

Tasting Notes

Medium-deep intensity. Dark cherry-red with ruby rim. Long legs. Clear and bright. Complex aromas, well combined bouquet. We can find ripe red fruit notes, toast and herbal hints and a slight mineral touch. Smooth and balanced tannins. Long length, equilibrated acidity that reinforces its silkiness without weakening it. Long and persistent aftertaste, bringing back the toast and herbal hints.
