

# *Olarra Clasico Gran Reserva*

## The Producer

Bodegas Olarra was created in 1973. It is situated on the outskirts of the city of Logroño in Rioja Alta. The Y shaped building is designed to make optimum use of the space for both production and ageing of the wine. The clay and chalky soil is watered by the rain and the Ebro River. This area also benefits from warm sunshine and the influence of the Mediterranean and Atlantic coasts.

## Tasting Notes

Aromas of black cherry, black raspberry and red currant excite your nose in this enticing Rioja wine. It has flavors of ripe red plum, black raspberry and cassis all wrapped in silky soft tannins. The finish is long-lasting and there's a splash of bright acidity in the post palate. In the mouth it is medium-bodied, tasty and with tannins present that are very well integrated into the whole. A wine that exhibits spicy and fruity sensations in the middle, with excellent freshness and liveliness. Long and complex retronasal passage, strengthened with smoky and toasted oak echoes.



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
