The Producer

LaGravera was born when the Arno family decided to carry out an unusual undertaking: to restore an old gravel pit to turn it into a unique vineyard. The winery is located in the district of Alfarras, in the Segria region. Under the requirements of organic and biodynamic agriculture, they work the 11.3 hectares of vines using advanced planting, monitoring and control techniques. Their tenacity and philosophy that respects the fruit and the environment has earned them the Special Mention for Innovation, Quality and Sustainable Development at the Rutas del Vino de Espana Awards in 2011.

General Information

Type of wine: Red.
Alcohol Content: 14.0%
Grape Variety: Garnacha Tinta, Tempranillo, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon.
Origin: D.O. Costers de Segre
Vinification: Ecologic wine. Manual harvest selected between mid-September and October, in 8kg boxes that are kept in a chamber right after harvesting at 6 degrees. Fermentation 50% in cement and 50% in stainless steel and 100% wild yeast. Light passage through French oak barrels, medium toast.

Tasting Notes

The other face of the wine: when you simply want a wine that relaxes you and makes you enjoy its pleasant double personality of ripe fruit with freshness and a light touch of French oak. Deep dairy aromas with hints of raspberries and blackberries, with an elegant background of unroasted chocolate. Sweet and soft palate that encourages us to continue drinking to meet again with a new fruity explosion and a light memory of vanilla.



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
